Anita Luvera Mayer was introduced to looms and weaving by her mother-in-law and following six years of self-study, experimentation and selling, Anita turned her focus to garments in 1972. Anita's fiber art now includes a wide range of surface design and embellishment as a result of her seven years of study in embroidery and design at the Gail Harker Creative Design Center. Her work has been included in national and international shows and she gives lectures and workshops throughout the United States and Canada. The Golden Thread- Kassia St Clair – a book about how fabric changed history. Starting with Fibres in the Cave, throuid weaving of shrouds, the importance of the silk trade, woolens in England, cottons, embellishment eras, factory production, space fabrics – the history of fabric developments and its' influence on world history.

The Secret Lives of Colour - Kassia St Clair – tells the stories of 75 shades, dyes and hues – where they come from, their importance in fashion, wars, plagues, etc. Each famous colour is described, with that colour visually shown, and its' importance in history. A visual colour treat.
